Green microphone = Unmuted: People in the meeting can hear you.


Red microphone = Muted: No one in the meeting can hear you.


If you cannot hear or be heard

If your microphone volume is too low or too high



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

Camera control (Start Video/Stop Video button) is located on the command row.







Green dot in camera = Camera is on: People in the meeting can see you.
