



## PRIMARY SOURCE DATA USED TO VERIFY AN APPLICANT'S CREDENTIALS FOR LICENSURE

The following processes are utilized by the Physician Assistant Board to verify an applicant's credentials for licensure as a physician assistant:

- 1. Obtain certification of the applicant's successful completion of a physician assistant accredited training program directly from the physician assistant training program.
- 2. Obtain verification of the applicant achieving a passing score of the Physician Assistant National Certification Examination directly from the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants.
- 3. Obtain verification(s) directly from the respective licensing agency for each health care related license, registration or certificate previously or currently held by the applicant.
- 4. Obtain results of a National Practitioner Data Bank Self-Query Report.
- 5. Obtain the results of background checks from the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the California Department of Justice for convictions of crimes substantially related to the practice as a physician assistant.
