**NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED
REGULATIONS**

Application, Exam Scores, Addresses, and Records

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Physician Assistant Board (Board) has proposed changes to Division 13.8 of Title 16, California Code of Regulations (CCR) sections 1399.506, 1399.507, 1399.511 and 1399.530, and to repeal Sections 1399.535, 1399.536, 1399.538, 1399.539, 1399.546 and 1399.556, related to application, exam scores, addresses, and records.

While notice of this rulemaking was filed with the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) and published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on February 20, 2026, the Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action, Proposed Regulatory Language and Initial Statement of Reasons were inadvertently not posted to the Board's website and the Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action was not sent by mail or electronic communication to persons required to receive notice on February 20, 2026. Rather, these actions were taken on February 23, 2026. Therefore, the Board is extending the end date of the public comment period.

Written comments about the proposed regulations must be **received by the Board at its office no later than April 10, 2026.**
